

Group Build Days with Habitat for Humanity Las Vegas

We welcome volunteers of all skills levels to our construction sites—we are happy to teach newcomers!

- Volunteers should arrive on the worksite promptly at 7:30am and the day will finish at 2:30pm. Lunch is usually around 11:30am.
- Volunteers should arrange their own lunch and any additional refreshments they might want.
- Sturdy, closed-toe shoes are absolutely mandatory (sneakers and hiking boots are ok).
- Volunteers should wear weather appropriate clothing that can get dirty.
- Habitat Las Vegas provides professional supervision, tools, safety equipment, and water.
- All volunteers will need to sign a waiver before beginning work on the construction site.
- All volunteers must be over the age of 16—those between 16 and 18 must have a waiver signed by a parent or guardian and be accompanied by a parent or guardian on the construction site.
- We can accommodate groups of 10-30 volunteers on our construction sites.
- To reserve a build day, contact the Volunteer Services Manager, Kelli Kristo, with your preferred date and group size. We encourage you to reserve a day several weeks in advance!
- Once you have reserved your build day, the Volunteer Services Manager will inform you as to the precise location of the worksite closer to the build day.

We encourage groups to participate in our fundraising challenge by sponsoring their build day. The sponsorship covers construction costs, safety equipment, and professional supervision on the site.
